# STORK Piloted in two phases

- STORK
  - Natural person identification
  - Mainly citizen eGovernment services
  - Pilot operation 2010-2011 (and beyond)
- STORK 2.0
  - Extended by representation and mandates
  - Both citizen and business services in eGovernment and in private sector applications
  - Pilot operation from end 2014

- Student Mobility



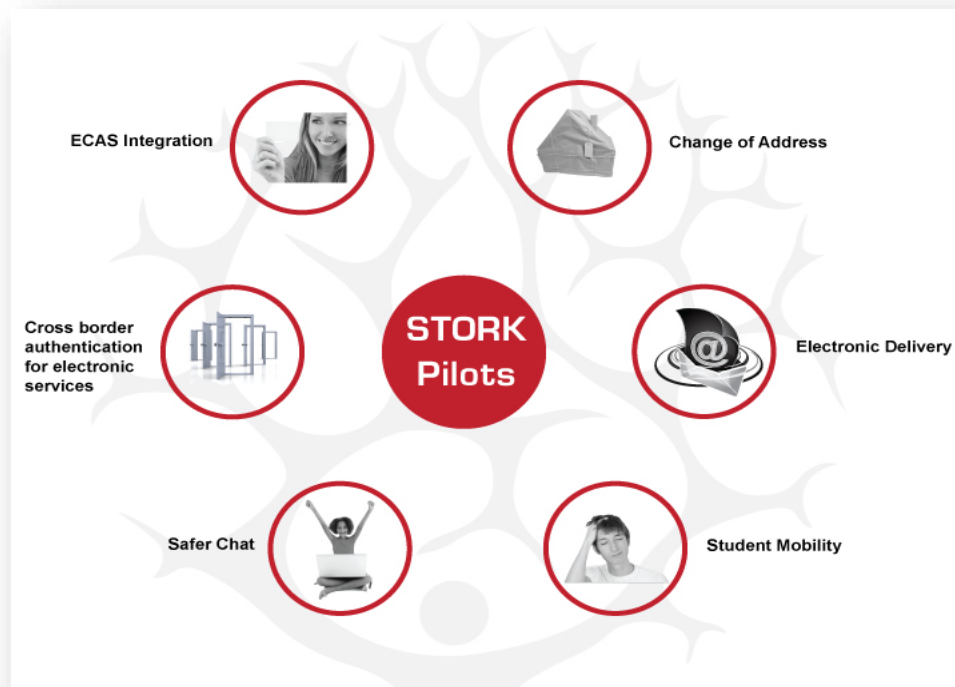

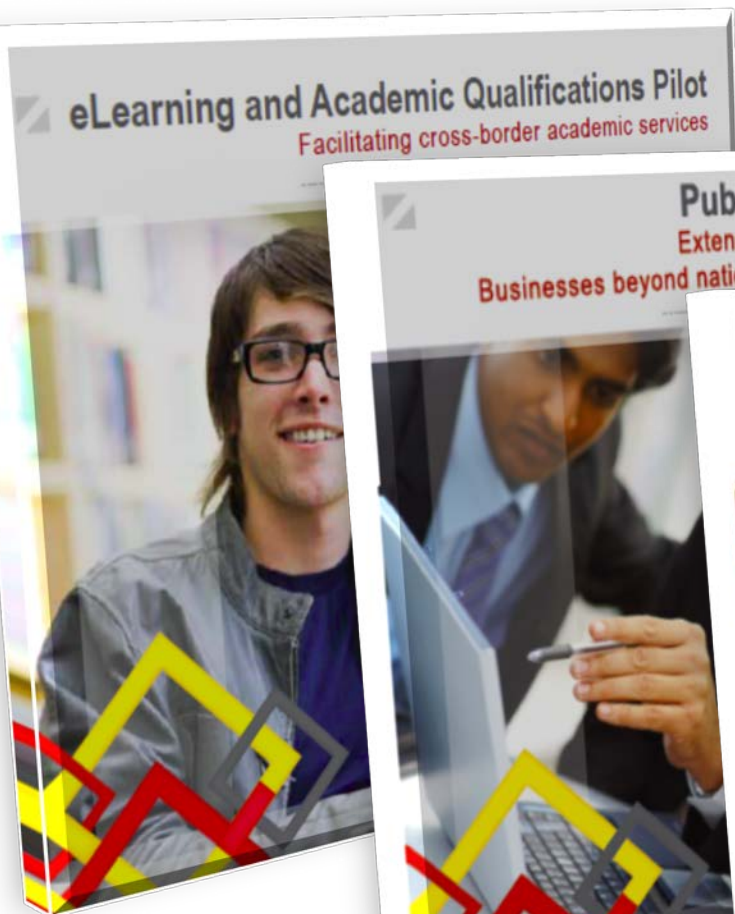

  - Open a bank account online
  - Internet banking online
- Demo story
  - An Austrian citizen uses citizen card to open an account at an Slovenian bank
  - Needs eID and eSignature on bank form

# Demo: eBusiness



- eBusiness
  - Login to an eBusiness portal
  - Pilot representation, i.e. “on behalf”
- Demo story
  - CEO of an Austrian SME authenticates at the Italian Chamber of Commerce
  - Needs an “electronic mandate”, derived from the Austrian Company Register
