

Armin Stocker (*1972 in Austria) has been Assistant Professor since 2018 and Deputy Head of the Institute for Construction and Design Principles at TU Graz (KOEN Institute).

Armin Stocker studied architecture and he holds a PhD from Graz University of Technology.

He was co-founder of the architectural firm S.DREI Architektur in Graz, Austria and until 2012 was primarily responsible for international projects in Paris, Madrid, Rome, Milan, Warsaw and Shanghai.

Armin has been teaching design subjects at TU Graz since 2001, has international teaching and research experience, for example at TU Berlin, among others, teaches at Bachelor and Master and supervises Master theses in architectural design and construction. He is working on his habilitation Constructive Design Basics, which he will complete in 2025.

Armin Stocker is the editor of scientific publications on design-based research approaches, such as Learning from Berlin (Graz, 2019) and he is the author of numerous scientific publications on spatial theory and spatial perception strategies. About his project YOSTAR. Young Styrian Architecture, the accompanying exhibition was shown in Graz, Maribor and Berlin as well as in Brussels.

Armin Stocker was Vice-President of the Central Association of Architects in Styria and he was appointed in 2020 by the Styrian Provincial Government to the Graz Old Town Expert Commission.
