

Armin Stocker

Armin Stocker has been an assistant professor and deputy head of the Institute for the Fundamentals of Construction and Design (KOEN Institute) at Graz University of Technology (Austria) since 2018 and is currently working on his habilitation entitled "Constructive Fundamentals of Design". He studied architecture at Graz University of Technology and received his doctorate in 2018 with the dissertation "The Dimension of the Urban in Literature". International teaching experience, including at TU Berlin, UdK Berlin, HS Mainz, FH Erfurt and IU. Internationale Hochschule Berlin, as well as lecturing in Paris, Dublin, Berlin and Vienna.

The accompanying exhibition of his publication "YOSTAR – Young Styrian Architecture" was shown in Graz, Maribor, Brussels and Berlin. He was co-founder and managing partner of the internationally active and multiple award-winning architecture firm S.DREI Architektur. Armin Stocker has been running his own firm, "Atelier Armin Stocker", since 2012. He has been honored with the International Architecture Award of the Chicago Athenaeum and the best architects award, among others.

Armin Stocker was Vice President of the ZV-Steiermark until 2017 and was appointed to the Graz Old Town Expert Commission by the Styrian State Government in 2020. Since 2024, Armin Stocker has been an expert on the Styrian townscape.
